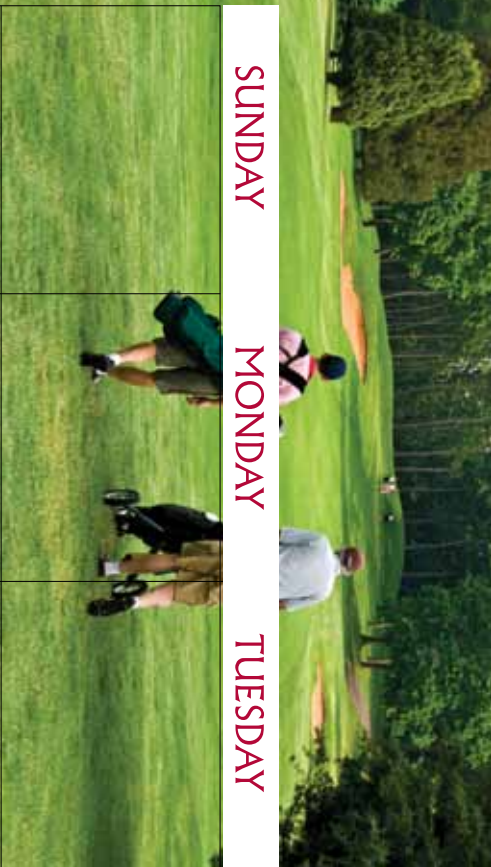
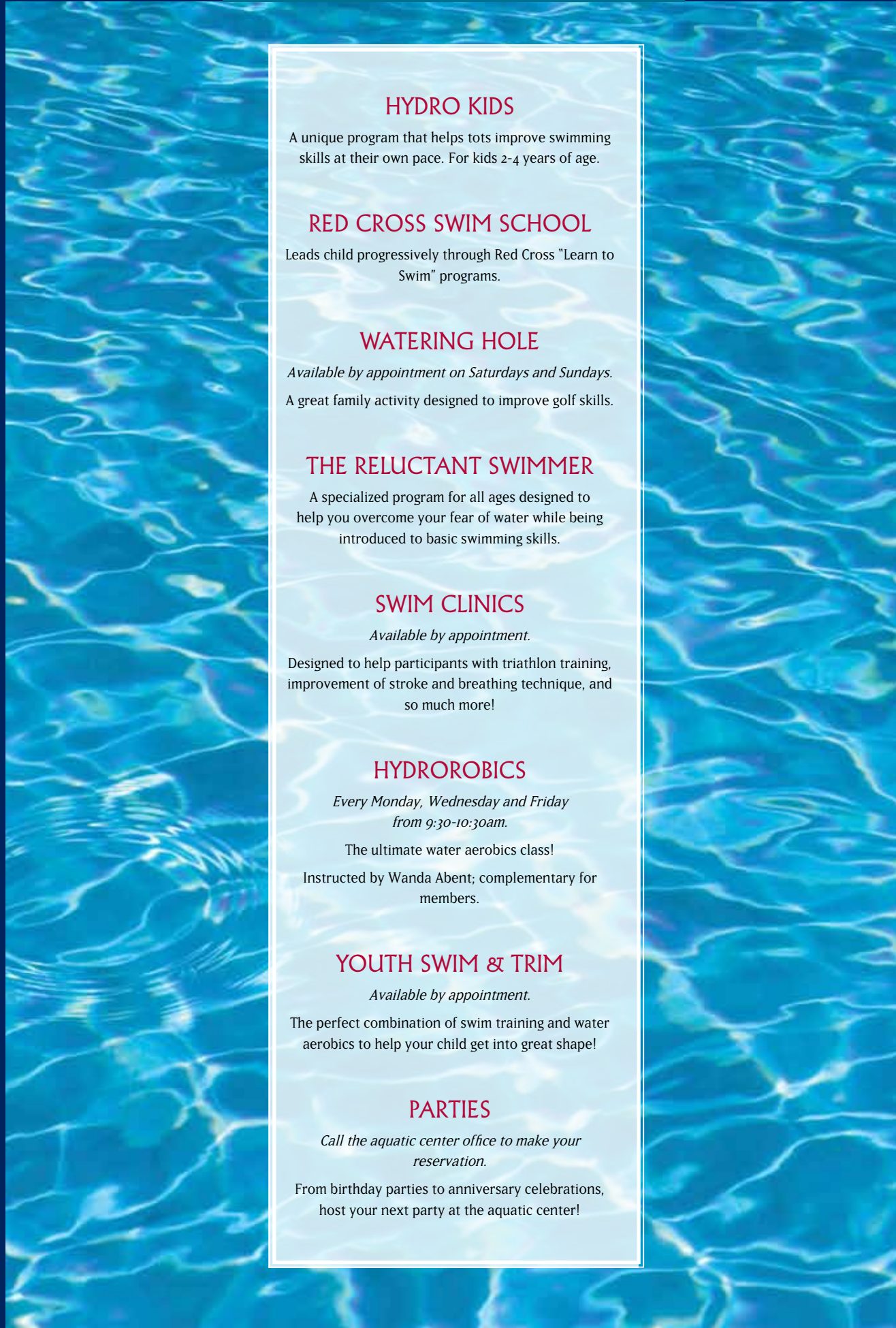

One of the questions we hear most often is "What is our Guest Policy?" Here is a brief description: A guest can play a maximum of (6) times during the membership year and no guest play is allowed on Saturday mornings. This policy is in place to protect the rights and privileges of your membership. The Club does record guest play and does notify guests when they have reached their limit. Unfortunately, we have had to turn away guests in the Golf Shop which puts the Club's staff in a difficult situation. Although the staff will do everything we can to make sure your guest is accommodated, it is the responsibility of the member to know the rule and not put the staff in this uncomfortable position.
